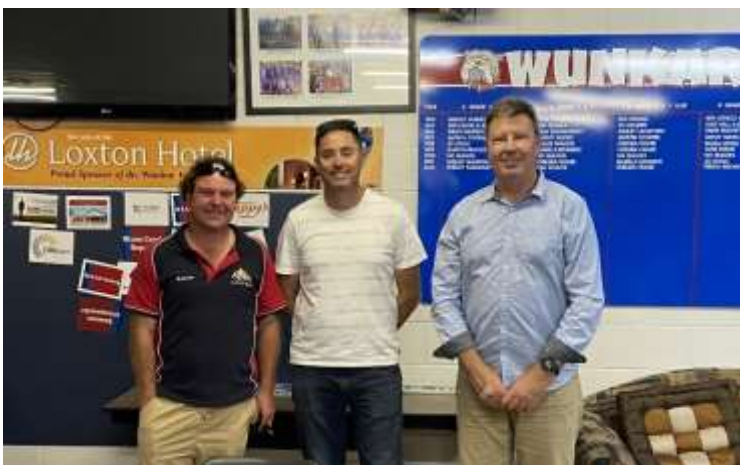
The Loxton Rotary Club held a General Meeting at the Wunkar Football Club on 11 October 2023.

Both Rotary & Apex members were also fortunate to have Mantung locals Mick & Suzy Evans speak to the group sharing their recent significant challenges including the personal sudden loss of a family member, a life-threatening illness and mental health battles and finding ways to move forward.

Suzy & Mick shared their inspiring and brave story of facing a perfect storm of bereavement and unknown Guillain-Barré syndrome (GBS) demonstrating that these issues are real and can impact any of us without warning. Mick went from shearing one day to hospital the next diagnosed with GBS which is a rare disorder where the body's immune system damages nerve. The damage to the nerves causes muscle weakness and sometimes paralysis. While its cause is not fully understood, the syndrome often follows infection with a virus or bacteria.



The challenge of getting up to face each day saw Suzy use the experience by studying positive psychology and now is a Mental Health Ambassador.

Suzy & Mick also spoke the next morning at the Loxton Men's Shed to an even larger audience of 70. Local legends!

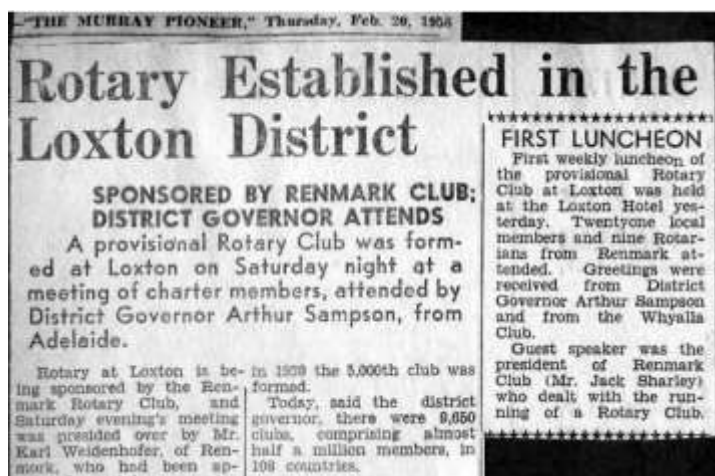


A Century of Service Since 1924

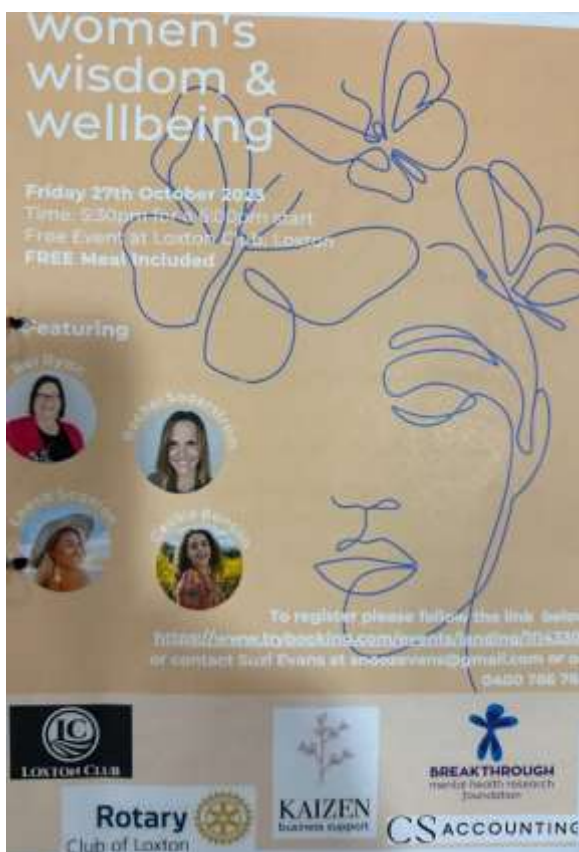

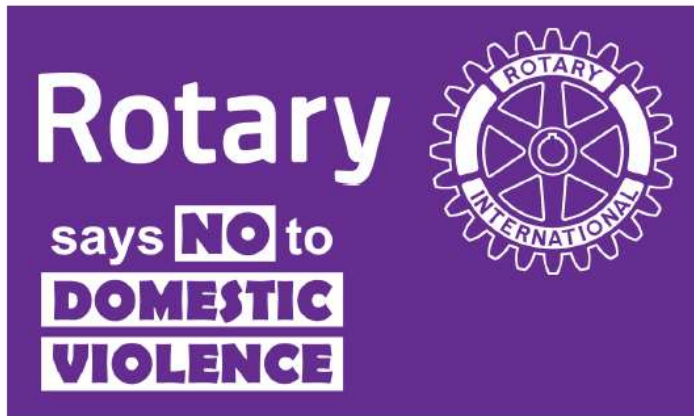

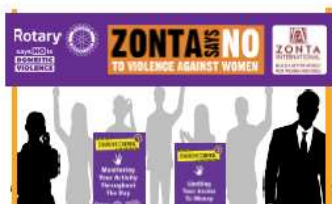
