Sarah provided us with an enthusiastic story of her Long Service Leave trip to Southern Africa, taking in South Africa, Botswana, Zambia and Zimbabwe. She was away during June and July, celebrating her 30th birthday.

Animals featured heavily in her travelogue, particularly elephants and rhinoceros. The dilemma facing rhino conservation clearly impacted on her. The idea is that because the endangered animals are killed solely for the value of their horns on the black market as aphrodisiacs, removing their horns humanely and safely, and selling the horn into a quasi-legal market may save the animals. There is not agreement in the country that this is a good principle.

Highlights for Sarah included visiting Victoria Falls and being impressed by their volume, of baobab trees, and seeing six lionesses, elephants and giraffe just in one morning. She also described the breathtaking sunrises and sunsets.








